

Missing Number Addition Word Problems

Read each word problem. Fill in the missing number to complete the addition sentence.

1. Emma has 3 crayons.
She gets some more crayons.
Now she has 8 crayons.



$$3 + \square = 8$$

2. Oliver has 2 toy cars.
His dad gives him some more
toy cars. Now he has 7 toy cars.



$$2 + \square = 7$$

3. Sophia picked 4 flowers.
She picked some more flowers.
Now she has 9 flowers.



$$4 + \square = 9$$

4. Noah has 1 storybook.
He borrows some more storybooks
from the library. Now he has
6 storybooks.



$$1 + \square = 6$$

5. Lily collected 5 seashells
at the beach. She found some
more seashells. Now she has
10 seashells.



$$5 + \square = 10$$

6. Jack has 3 balloons.
He gets some more balloons
at a party. Now he has 7 balloons.



$$3 + \square = 7$$
