



Singular And Plural Pronouns


Read about singular pronouns and plural pronouns with examples.


Singular Pronoun
 A singular pronoun is used for one person, one place or one thing.
 Examples:

 **I** am a boy.





 **It** is a cat.

Plural Pronoun
 A plural pronoun is used for more than one person, place or thing.
 Examples:

 **We** are friends.

 **They** are birds.
