Examples:

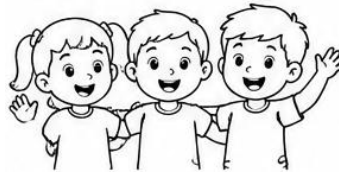


I am a boy.











Plural Pronoun
