

Punctuation:

Full stop



● Used in writing to indicate strong emotion, emphasis, or surprise.

Question mark



● Used to indicate the end of a sentence in written English

Comma



● Used to indicate the beginning and end of a direct quotation or to set off titles of short works

Exclamation mark



● Used at the end of a sentence to indicate that it is a direct question

Quotation mark



● Used to indicate a brief pause in a sentence or to separate elements within a sentence
